## FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

### KTM RC390 Belly Pan

### BPFL-7231 - BPCL-7231





## Belly Pan, Race, (Carbon), Cup Style, KTM RC390 (BPFL-7231 and BPCL-7231

This lightweight belly pan is modelled on the KTM RC390 Cup shape, but being made from lightweight carbon and high quality epoxy resin, (BPCL-7321) or made from high quality epoxy resin, (BPFL-7231) it is stronger and more flexible so more likely to survive in the event of a crash. It is reinforced with carbon/Kevlar at the mounting points and is finished in a UV resistant clearcoat so no additional painting is necessary.

This product is supplied with all mounting hardware (including the left rear stay which is not supplied with the KTM product) so you can install this with stock footpegs or any other aftermarket make such as TYGA Performance. It is also supplied with a rubber bung to make the belly pan fluid retentive.

*This product can be fitted to a street bike as well as cup racing bikes.*

*Please note, this product fits the 390 only. For the 125 and 200 models, we don't have information on if it will fit or not*



LH Stay:

This fits on the rearward M10 bolt that secured the step hanger to the frame.





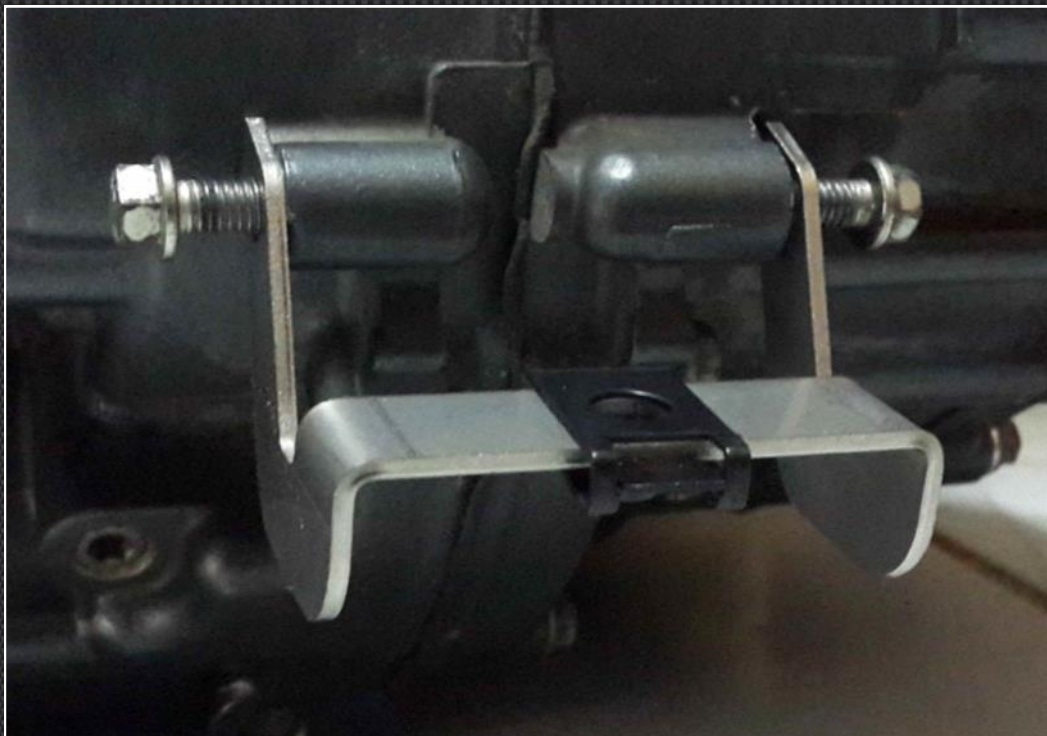
### RH bolt and Spacer Bush:

This secures to an M6 threaded boss on the standard RH step hanger. The TYGA step kit also has an M6 threaded hold for this application.



### Front Stay:

Remove the stock front stay that holds the inner cowling piece and replace with the TYGA part. It retains the standard bolts. This is at the front of the engine just under the radiator.



Do all the bolts up finger tight at first and check the position and clearance of the belly pan. Once you're happy, do it all up tight.
